### **Covid Updates**

With the increasing numbers of Covid cases and the new Omicron variant we are continually monitoring the latest government guidance and making the necessary adjustments to play our part in keeping everyone safe.



To keep our staff, pupils, parents and visitors as safe as possible in the coming weeks, the Trust have stated that the following measures must be implemented in school;

- Staff will be asked to wear face coverings in communal places around the school.
- All visitors to our school will be asked to wear face coverings.
- We recommend that parents wear face coverings when dropping off in the mornings and picking up at the end of the day.

As a community we will do our best to support any families who find themselves struggling with guidance and the law. ## Nativity Performance and Church Service – **Now online**

It is with a heavy heart that we have to announce that we are no longer permitted to allow parents and carers to watch any performances that we

will be holding in school/church. You will hopefully have all received a letter with information we have received directly from the Trust - "Whilst the government has said that nativities should go ahead, this is still a matter for risk assessment. With this in mind, we feel that schools should now move to online rather than in-person performances. We appreciate that this may be a disappointment for some and very short notice but, unfortunately, Covid is fast-moving and we need to continually reassess the risk for the staff, children and visitors and adjust our control measures accordingly". — We are extremely disappointed with this outcome, it is not something any of the staff at St Joseph's wanted to happen, but unfortunately, we have to do our best to keep the whole of the St Joseph's Community Safe. We would not want to put anyone at risk of missing a further Christmas with their families this year.

All parents will be notified when performances have been recorded and how you can view these via a private, unlisted secure link.
