#### **Covid Restrictions**

With the increasing numbers of Covid cases and the new Omicron variant we are continually monitoring the latest government guidance and making the necessary adjustments to play our part in keeping everyone safe. Restrictions for individual events is detailed with the event details in the newsletter.

The law now states that masks be worn in shops and on public transport, as a school we have also made the decision to ask that all parents and visitors on site wear a mask. You now start to see staff wearing masks in the playground at the start and end of the day. In the office, we have the window and the distance between yourself and a staff member, but please ask if you would feel safer for staff to also put a mask on and we would be happy to do this.

Another change is with regards to people coming into the UK and the need for a PCR test. If you are planning on going abroad to either visit family or take an unauthorised holiday, please note that your child/ren will not be allowed back into school until a negative PCR result has been received or the relevant isolation period completed. The other change we need to be aware of is with regards to the Omicron variant. Regardless of age or vaccination status, any person who has come into contact with an individual who may have been infected with the Omicron variant will need to self-isolate. This is law.

As a community we will do our best to support any families who find themselves struggling with guidance and the law. Please, if your child has any symptoms of Covid, get them tested through a PCR and keep them off school until you receive a negative result. This request has also been made to all staff.

Our Wrap Around Club will be hosting a film night and would like to invite all children to attend. They will be watching the Grinch whilst Hot Dogs, Popcorn and other treats are served. There is a charge of £6 for this which needs to be paid on ParentMail by Monday 6<sup>th</sup> December. All children attending the movie night must be collected by 5.30pm.

#### Nativity Tickets for in School Performances – 14th and 16th December

As we were unable to allow parents to watch performances last year, we do not want to disappoint again. Therefore, we are inviting parents to watch their child's performances this year, but with restrictions in place. All parents will be issued ticket. You will be issued two tickets, per child, per performance. If the tickets are not used, please do not pass these to other parents, as we are trying to limit the number of household bubbles in school to keep our staff, yourselves and your children safe. We would also like to request that masks are worn when in school, and if possible negative LFT's taken prior to attendance.
