EU Settlement Scheme DEADLINE 30th JUNE 2021:

Newark and Sherwood District Council have provided the attached leaflet for us to share with our families who may need to apply to the EU Settlement Scheme. Under the UK's Withdrawal Agreement following the Brexit Vote in 2016, the vast majority of EU citizens must apply, before the deadline of the 30th June 2021. The scheme is free and EU citizens should fill out the application form online.
