Reminder: Start and Finish Times:

Bicycles, Scooters and similar forms of transport to school

Following an incident in the playground this week, can we please remind all parents, carers and children that if you cycle, scoot, skate or use any other similar form of vehicle to get your children to school to take extra care. Please can you dismount from the bike etc before coming on to the school premises including the playground and drive. Bikes etc need to be walked into the bike shed where they should be stored safely for collection at the end of the day. Parents who bring younger siblings to school to collect children, please ensure suitable supervision is provided. This is to ensure the health and safety of all visitors, pupils and staff and to avoid accidents occurring.

Social distancing, masks and following government guidelines regarding restrictions

It is important that we all continue to follow the restrictions and guidelines in place to ensure that we do our very best to keep the whole school community. This includes maintaining a 2 metre distance whilst on the playground and whilst waiting for the gates to open on the pavement outside of school.

Please ensure that only 1 adult brings the children onto the school grounds, to reduce the numbers of people in close proximity at any time. Please also can we ask that once you have dropped off or collected your

children, you leave the school grounds swiftly, without gathering to wait with other parents. Masks should also be worn whilst on the school premises.

Please also remember there is a one way system for entry and exit to the younger years' classrooms, to assist with maintaining distances.

Staff will be in the school playground at the start and end of the day to ensure that we all follow the guidelines and to provide support to parents where necessary.

Wrap Around Care Bookings

Please can we remind all parents that it is important to book children in for all of the Wrap Around Care sessions available (Breakfast Club, Early Birds, Afterschool Club).
