**ParentMail** will be used for communication with regards to items with a financial implication i.e. School Dinners, Wrap Around Care, Trips and Events. Unfortunately, we are no longer able to accept cash in the school office, except for charity purposes, all payments need to me made through ParentMail.

**MarvellousMe** will be used for rewarding children and sending positive messages home along with general communication, such as newsletters and logging reading activities from home.

For any parent having difficulties with either system, we are holding dropping sessions every morning next week between 8am and 9am, where Mrs Chambers or Mrs Broad, will assist you with using the systems. If these times are not suitable, please speak to the office who will be happy to arrange a more convenient time.
