Attendance

Trips

A reminder with regards to a couple of trips that have deadlines approaching:



Creswell Crags (Year 3) – 11th October 2021 - £15.00 – A reminder that we if we do receive sufficient voluntary contributions, we will need to cancel this visit. If you have not yet booked your child's place on the trip, payment and consent on parentmail is required by Wednesday 6th October 2021.

The vaccination team will be in school on Wednesday 1st October 2021 to deliver the vaccination to pupils with consent in Years Foundation 2 through to Year 6. You should have received a letter this week through MarvellousMe providing further information. If you would like to give consent or decline the vaccine for your child, please follow the instructions below.

What do you need to do?

You **must** complete **one** online consent form for **each** of your children.

It is important every child has a completed form which states if you would like them to receive the flu vaccination spray **or not**.
