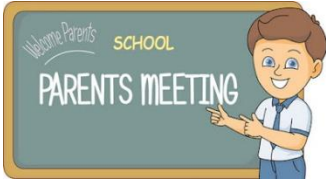

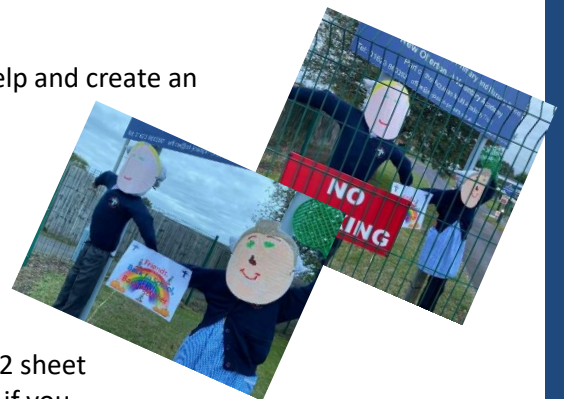
Mexican/Spanish Themed Lunch

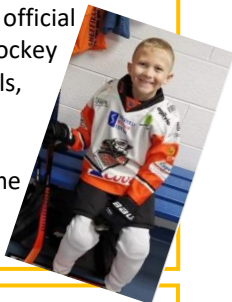
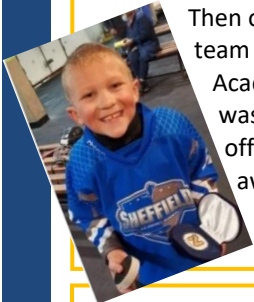

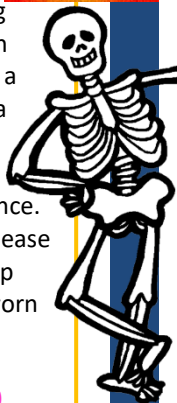
