Design and Technology - Why we cook food

Explore how pulses and root vegetables are softened by cooking. Look at and feel a variety of dried pulses and root vegetables, including lentils, chickpeas, kidney beans, butter beans, carrots, parsnips and turnips, and discuss why they need cooking. Prepare by peeling and chopping. Discuss hygiene rules around food preparation and supervise the use of sharp knives. Cook the vegetables and allow the children to cut and taste them, discussing how they have changed after cooking.
