Book Focus: celebrations

We have discussed celebrations this week and have used our celebrations photographs sent from home in discussions and our Literacy work.

Little wandle phonics

We have learnt the graphemes: **g, o, c, k**

Try **writing** these letters in your homework books or on a white board using the catch phrases in your homework book.

Try the initial sound and picture matching activity. Adult to say the word (tap) child to independently say what the initial sound is and attempt to write the initial sound t.

Writing

Continue to practice writing names in homework books and using the yellow name sheets, supporting correct letter formation.

Reading

Please continue to read together at home, and enjoy stories together.

Children have been taught **s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k**

children to try reading these sounds.

Challenge blending words in books to support your child reading and hearing what the word is.

s-i-t = sit

Please record in your child reading records

Our children will be introduced to their first reading scheme books next week and they will read that same book with their adult over 3 days. This book will be sent home electronically through E Collins book. Information to follow.

Mathematics

We have been getting to know your child through play and observations for the past three weeks, and completing baseline tests. This information will be shared with you during parent consultations.
