### Grammar Focus 1: Expanded Noun Phrases

An expanded noun phrase adds more detail to the noun by adding one or more adjectives

Tricia bought the *skins with the blue spots* for herself.

### Grammar Focus 2: Semi-colons in coordinated sentences

Semi-colons are used to separate two main clauses that are clearly related to each other but could stand on their own as sentences. They can be used to replace a conjunction.

I have a rugby match next week and I really hope we win.

Becomes:

I have a rugby match next week; I really hope we win.
