Visit the polar bears at Yorkshire Wildlife park with your family and learn about their behaviour and lifestyle. Take photographs if you can!	Using a range of snowy images to create a polar collage. Write a diary-style piece describing the changes and how the human race has adapted to cope.
With an adult, visit a local marina or lake and look at the types of boats there. Think about whether these boats would be suitable to be used on a polar exploration? Create your own Arctic and Antarctic word search puzzles using all the new words you have learned during this project. Challenge a grown up to solve it!
