

Grammar Focus I: Indefinite Pronouns

Pronouns used to refer to people or things without saying exactly who or what they are.

I do not want **anything** else.

At four o'clock, there was somebody at the door, knocking loudly.

Examples of indefinite pronouns:				
Anyone	Anything	Anybody	Everybody	Everywhere
Few	Less	Someone	Samebody	All
Most	Some	One	Other	Either

Grammar Focus 2: Reported Speech

The reporting of what someone said, introduced with the relative pronoun 'that' and without using speech marks/inverted commas.

Miss Wallis, who was incredibly tired, said that she was extremely pleased with our work!

The captain promised that the sinking of the Titanic was not his fault!
