### Resolution

The problem is resolved.

### Ending

The main character continues safely on their journey.

The purpose of the text is to make the character feel excited about going on an adventure.

### Grammar Focus 1: To use coordinating conjunctions.

A coordinating conjunction links together parts of a sentence.

Suddenly, she stopped and looked up at the tower.
