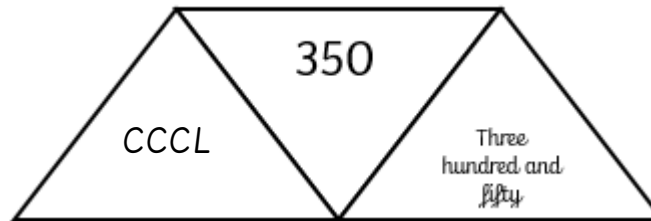

Key Information

If a smaller symbol appears after a larger symbol, you add them together.

E.g. VI = V + I = 5 + 1 = 6.

If a smaller symbol appears before a larger symbol, you subtract the.

E.g. IX = X - I = 10 - 1 = 9.
