Plants

Key vocabulary	
germination	When the conditions are right, the
	seed soaks up <b>water</b> and swells,
	and the tiny new plant bursts out
	of its shell. This is called
	germination.
sprout	When a plant <b>sprouts</b> , it grows new
	shoots.
shoot	A <b>shoot</b> grows upwards from the
	seed or plants to find <b>sunlight</b> .
seed	Seed dispersal is when the seeds
dispersal	move away from the parent plant.
	They can be moved by the wind or
	animals.
What do plants need to grow well?	
sunlight	All plants need light from the sun
	to grow well. Some plants need lots
	of sunlight. Some plants only need
	a little <b>sunlight</b> .
water	All plants need <b>water</b> to grow.
	Without water, seeds and bulbs will
	rot <b>germinate</b> .
temperature	Temperature is how warm or cold
	something or somewhere is. Some
	plants like cooler temperatures and
	some like warmer <b>temperatures</b> .
nutrition	Food or nourishment. Plants make
	their own food in their leaves using
	sunlight.
