Collage	Cutting, arranging and sticking materials like paper, fabric etc to a background.
Identity	Your qualities or beliefs that make you unique.
Mixed Media	Art made from a combination of different materials.
Monoprint	A print that can only be made exactly the same way once.
Multi-media	Artwork that includes audio and video elements.
Photomontage	Collage made from photographs
Self-Portrait	A portrait of an artist, made by the artist.

Key Knowledge

- 1 Line can be used beyond drawing and applied to different art forms.
- 2 Pattern can be created in many different ways, eg in the rhythm of brushstrokes in a painting (like the work of van Gogh) or in repeated shapes within a composition.
- 3 Colours can be symbolic and have meanings that vary according to your culture or background, eg red for danger or for celebration
- 4 Line, tone, form and shade can be used to create movement in objects.
- 5 Henry Moore was an artist who developed sculptures based on line drawings and worked in mixed medias.

1	Year 1	The primary colours are blue, yellow and red and can be used to create all other colours,
2	Year 1	Colours can be blended softly to create other colours and depths.
3	Year 3	Using light and dark colours next to each other creates contrast.
4	Year 4	Applying colours in different methods can add texture to a piece of art.
