Key Information

- 1 The Last Supper happened the night before Jesus died on the cross.
Jesus shared bread and wine with his disciples. He blessed it and said it was His body and blood do this in memory of Him.
- 2 There are four parts of the Mass. Introductory Rites, The Liturgy of the Word, The Liturgy of the Eucharist and The Concluding Rites.
- 3 The Eucharistic Prayer is said during the Consecration of the bread and wine.
- 4 During the Eucharist, the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.
- 5 The parish family go out from Mass in peace and thanksgiving to love and serve God.
