applique	Decorative needlework in which pieces of fabric are sewn or stuck onto a larger piece to form a pattern
motif	. An image or design that can be repeated to create a pattern
sequin	A small, shiny metal or plastic disc.
textile	A fabric made by hand or machine
Sewing template	a template of the parts needed to make a product. Sewing patterns are usually made from paper.

Key Information

- 1 Cath Kidston is a British textile and homeware designer. She founded the Cath Kidston brand. Her prints are based on traditional patterns.

They have bright, colourful designs with spots, stripes, flowers and other motifs.
- 2 To thread a needle by cutting the thread, dampening one end and squeezing the strands together before poking the thread through the eye of the needle.
- 3 Fabric can be joined together using a running stitch
- 4 Fabric products can be improved by making them easier to use, more hardwearing or more attractive.
- 5 Embellishments including sequins, appliqué, buttons and printing can be used to decorate fabric.
