printing tile	A flat surface made of lino or wood that is used to create designs you can use over and over again.

Key Information

- Maps can be used as a stimulus to drawing and be shown in a creative way
- 2 Artwork can be made into a 3D structure A 3D map is called a 'relief map'
- Abstract art doesn't try to represent something realistically -instead uses shapes, colours, forms and mark-making to create artwork
- Lines and shapes can be added to a tile to print and produce a negative print
- Form: That 'composition' means how things are arranged on the page.
- 6 Shape: Shapes can be organic (natural) and irregular.
