### Key Vocabulary

<b>Newspaper</b>	Information and up to date news written in text
<b>fact:</b>	A fact is something that is true.
<b>captions:</b>	A caption is a small piece of information that goes next to a drawing or photograph. It tells you what the picture is.
<b>headline:</b>	A headline is the title of a newspaper report. It gives a little bit of information on what the report is about.

### Key Information

- 5 W's feature in a newspaper report. These are: who, where, when why and what.
- Commas** can be used to separate objects  
Eg.  
*I needed sugar, eggs, flour and butter.*
- Contractions**  
Words that are shortened and an apostrophe is used  
Eg.  
*I've - I have*  
*Won't - will not*  
*She'll - she will*  
*Couldn't - could not*
- What to include in a newspaper report  
include the name of the newspaper  
include a headline  
include pictures with captions  
include facts about the main event
