Read with your grown up for approximately 5 minutes every day. This can be any book, but please try to read your reading book during the week.

The reading book you receive will be one that you have used in class during our Guided Reading sessions. Make sure your adult writes in your reading record every time you read together.

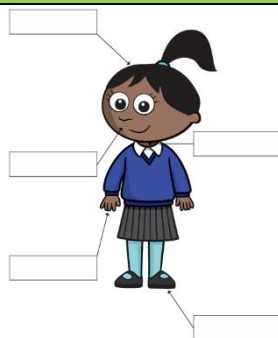
