Nottinghamshire	A county in the East Midlands of England
Nottingham	A city within Nottinghamshire
Robin Hood	A legendary outlaw, known for his adventures in Sherwood Forest
Sherwood Forest	A large area of historic woodland within Nottinghamshire
Outlaw	A person who has broken the law, who is escaping capture
Merry Men	Robin Hood's followers and friends
Timeline	A way to show events in the order in which they happened, which is called chronological order
Historical Sources	Any evidence that has been found about life in the past – e.g. documents, artefacts and stories
