Non-Chronological Report	A non-chronological report gives information about something but not in time order
Finger Spaces	Finger spaces are used between words so each word stands on its own and has its own meaning.
Sentence	A set of words that is complete in itself. It has a subject, predicate and stop.
Full Stop	A symbol to show that a sentence is complete

Key Information	
1	Finger spaces are used in between each word in a sentence.
2	A sentence has a subject, predicate and a way of stopping the sentence. We are using full stops.

Worked Examples

Finger spaces:

Create a space in between words in a sentence.

Robin Hood was an outlaw.

Full stops:

Use punctuation to show that each sentence is complete.

Robin Hood lived in Sherwood Forest He was a hero

Robin Hood lived in Sherwood Forest. He was a hero.
