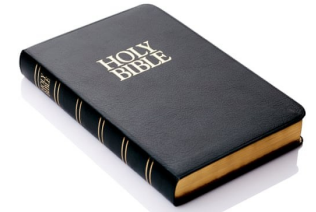
### Subject Specific Vocabulary

Word	Definition
<b>Prophet</b>	A person who delivered a message they received from God to the people.
<b>John the Baptist</b>	He was the last prophet of the Old Covenant who devoted his life to preparing the way for Jesus.
<b>Isaiah</b>	An Old Testament prophet who predicted of the coming of the Messiah.
<b>Messiah</b>	A saviour of a group of people. The 'anointed' one.
<b>Annunciation</b>	Meaning 'announcement'. The Bible story when Angel Gabriel told Mary she would have a baby.
<b>Magnificat</b>	The song of Mary. Hymn of praise after Mary was visited by the Angel Gabriel.
<b>Advent</b>	The first season of the Church's year and a time of waiting for the coming of Jesus at Christmas.
<b>Advent wreath</b>	Put up during Advent and symbolises God's everlasting love. The four candles on the Advent wreath represent the four weeks of Advent.

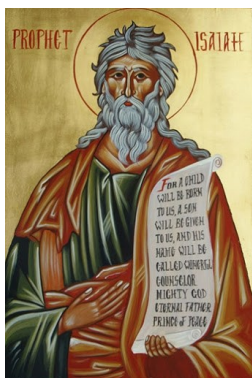
## Prophecy and Promise

### Prior Knowledge

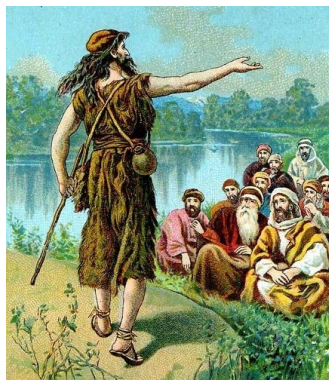
The Bible is split into two parts: the Old Testament and the New Testament.
