### Corporal Works of Mercy

1.	<b>Feed the hungry</b>	Provide food for those who are hungry or in need.
2.	<b>Give drink to the thirsty</b>	Provide water or other drinks to those who are thirsty or lack access to clean water.
3.	<b>Cloth the naked</b>	Provide clothing or other essentials to those who are in need.
4.	<b>Shelter the homeless</b>	Provide shelter or housing for those who are homeless or lack a safe place to stay.
5.	<b>Visit the sick</b>	Visiting and providing care and companionship to those who are ill or in hospital.
6.	<b>Visit those In prison</b>	Visiting and offering support to those who are in prison.
7.	<b>Bury those who have died</b>	Providing proper burial or funeral services for the deceased and supporting their loved ones.

1.	<b>The First Station</b>	Jesus is condemned to death.
2.	<b>The Second Station</b>	Jesus accepts the cross.
3.	<b>The Third Station</b>	Jesus falls the first time.
4.	<b>The Fourth Station</b>	Jesus meets his mother.
5.	<b>The Fifth Station</b>	Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus carry the cross.
6.	<b>The Sixth Station</b>	Veronica wipes the face of Jesus.
7.	<b>The Seventh Station</b>	Jesus falls the second time.
8.	<b>The Eighth Station</b>	Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem.
9.	<b>The Ninth Station</b>	Jesus falls the third time.
10.	<b>The Tenth Station</b>	Jesus is stripped of his garments.
11.	<b>The Eleventh Station</b>	Jesus is nailed to the cross.
12.	<b>The Twelfth Station</b>	Jesus dies on the cross.
13.	<b>The Thirteenth Station</b>	Jesus is taken down from the cross.
14.	<b>The Fourteenth Station</b>	Jesus is buried in the tomb.
