Key Vocabulary

wild plants	A wild plant seed grows where it falls. It does not need to be planted or cared for.
garden plants	Plants that people choose to grow and care for in their gardens.
deciduous	A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year.
evergreen	An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even winter.
flowers	Flowers are a living object that attract insects and birds.
trees	A tall plant that can live a long time.
bulbs	Something which is planted in soil and grows in to a plant.
