Each School has a separate contextual area of risk and mitigation.

Area of risk	Mitigation
Domestic Violence	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Staff are trained to recognise signs of domestic abuse• Strong links with external agencies for early intervention• Safe spaces and support plans for affected pupils• DSLs (Designated Safeguarding Leads) available for reporting and support
Physical Assault	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clear behaviour and anti-bullying policies enforced• Positive relationships promoted through PSHE• Supervised environments with regular risk assessments• Restorative approaches and conflict resolution strategies in place
E-safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Regular online safety lessons integrated into the curriculum• E-safety workshops for parents and carers• Internet filters and monitoring systems in place• Digital citizenship promoted throughout school life
