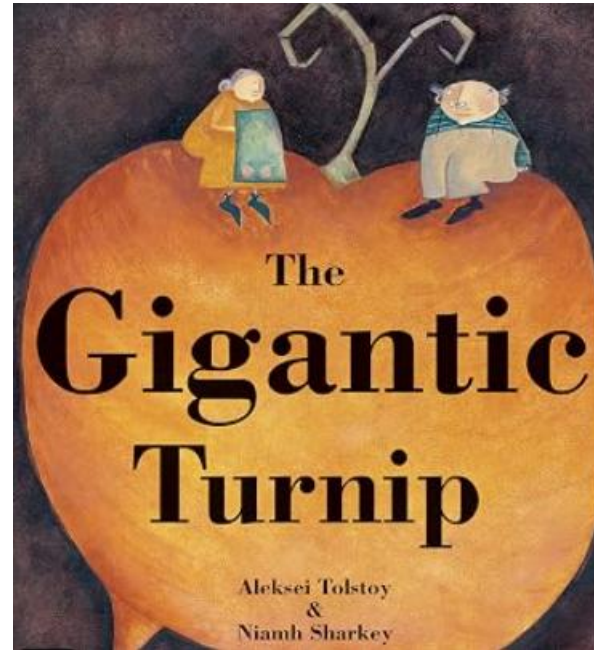


Key Vocabulary

stop	The punctuation at the end of the sentence
adjective	Describing words
Capital letter	Used at the beginning of every sentence
Full stop	A type of punctuation that would be used to end a sentence
