Key Vocabulary

poem	A poem is a short piece of writing that uses words in a special way to share feelings, pictures, sounds or ideas.
rhyme	. Rhyme is when words end with the same or a similar sound, such as cat and hat. It is common in poems, songs and nursery rhymes.
alliteration	Alliteration is when words close together start with the same sound.
Repeating phrases	Repeating phrases are words or groups of words used again and again in a poem, story or song. Writers use them to make the text easy to remember and fun to say aloud.
